

Four Steps to a Dream Career

At Bentley, career preparation starts the day you step on campus.

CDI 101

The Career Development Introduction 101 (CDI 101) equips all students with a comprehensive career toolkit. The six-week class — designed and taught by Bentley career advisers — is not required but is taken by more than 97 percent of students and addresses the foundational aspects of career development.



FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS

Bentley offers three options for first-year admission. Early Decision I and II are binding programs that provide you with your admission decision earlier. We recommend these programs if you know that Bentley is your first choice school. Our regular decision program is non-binding and you will be notified of your decision in mid-March. SCHOLARSHIPS, AWARDS AND FINANCIAL AID

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FIRST-YEAR AND TRANSFER APPLICANTS
Academic scholarships are awarded to top applicants, both domestic and international. Amounts range from partial to full tuition. Scholarship notifications are included with your admission decision.

MICRO-SCHOLARSHIPS

Bentley partners with RaiseMe to allow all first-year and transfer applicants the opportunity to earn micro-scholarships that recognize everyday achievements. These awards become part of your Bentley financial aid award. For more information on eligibility and program details, visit raise.me/join/bentley.

NEED-BASED AID

Bentley-funded need-based grants are available to U.S. citizens and permanent residents. There are three possible components to a financial aid package: grants, work opportunities, and low-interest student loans. International students and those with DACA status (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) are not eligible for federal, state or Bentley need-based aid. WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

First-year students applying for entry in the fall term are eligible to apply for the Women's Leadership Program, which recognizes women who have demonstrated strong leadership potential while in high school. Recipients participate in a four-year program that empowers young women with the essential skills, experiences and confidence to advance into leadership roles and includes a \$10,000 per year award. A separate application is required.

FIRSTGEN PRESIDENTIAL FELLOWS

This is a highly selective and prestigious program for first-generation college students with outstanding leadership potential. The program provides the full cost of attendance in grants and scholarships, as well as faculty mentors and access to exclusive workshops on academic success, networking and career development.
